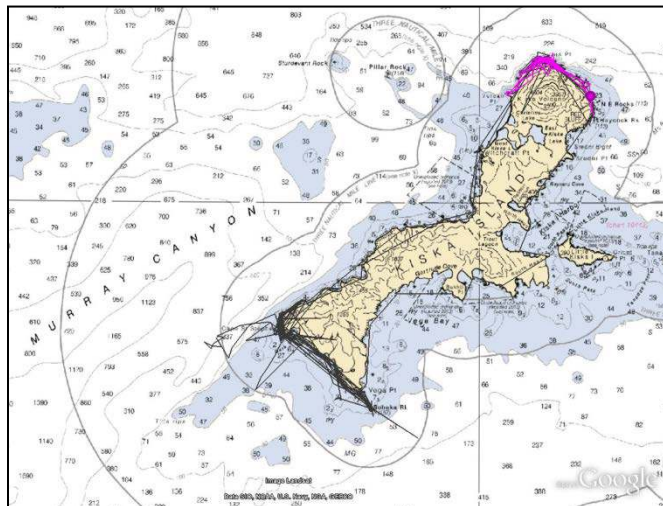




This update of positions is for three adult female Steller sea lions carrying satellite-linked tags deployed in October 2014. Maps are for informational purposes only as positions and track-lines are preliminary and subject to change. Tracks from this period indicated in color with the most current location noted. 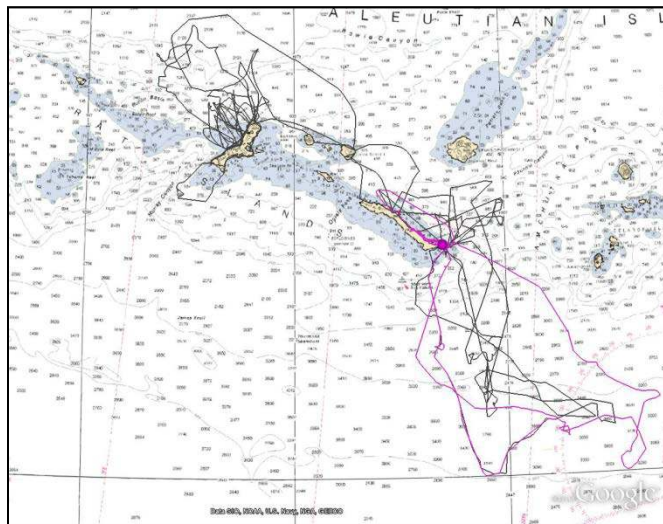
Kiska sea lion ‘=30’

Remained on the northern side of Kiska Island. On January 7 was near Northeast Rocks.



Kiska sea lion ‘=31’

Made a looping trip to about 75 nm south of the Delarof Islands, and was along the north side of Amchitka. On January 7 was at the northeast side of Amchitka.



Kiska sea lion ‘=32’

Moved along the Lake Point peninsula area at Adak Island, including a visit into Three Arm Bay. On January 7 was between Hook Point and Wedge Point.
